

# STATION CAR PARKS Train Based

There are currently two train based Station Car Park sites in operation within Sheffield

## Train site one Dore and Totley Station

Dore and Totley Station is managed by Northern Rail. Further station information is available by visiting [northernrail.org](http://northernrail.org).

**Location** Abbeydale Road South, Dore and Totley, Sheffield, South Yorkshire, S17 3LB.

**Capacity** The site has parking for at least 20 cars.

### How much does it cost?

Dore and Totley operates **FREE** parking. Train tickets are an additional cost.

## Train site two Sheffield Station

Sheffield Station is managed by East Midlands trains.

Car Parking is operated by Q-Park.

**Location** Turner Street, Sheffield, S1 4AA  
Telephone 0114 278 7914.

**Capacity** 678 spaces.

**Security** Sheffield Station Car Park operates a CCTV system and is staffed 24 hours a day.

# PARK & RIDE Bus Based

## Bus site Tesco - Abbeydale

Do you work near the Royal Hallamshire Hospital or University of Sheffield?

Then why not park your car at the free Park & Ride site at Tesco, Abbeydale and ride the dedicated 505 Park & Ride bus service to work?

It's open Monday to Friday from 0600-1900 and has a total of 200 spaces available.

Service 505 is a dedicated bus service operated by TM Travel. Please refer to the timetable overleaf for more information.

Service 85 operated by First, complements the dedicated 505 service from the Park & Ride site itself. Services 97 and 98 also operated by First are also available from nearby.

### How much does it cost?

The Park & Ride site is free to use. You can purchase tickets for the service 505 on board at the following prices:

**£2.90** return per day for car and driver

**£9.75** weekly ranger ticket

**£13.00** 10 trip ticket

Accompanying passengers will pay the same fares as stated above.

Tickets for services 85, 97 and 98 are bought on board each bus. For up to date ticket prices, please ask the driver.

**Please note** - Tickets bought on service 505 cannot be used on First service 85, 97 or 98 and vice versa. All concessionary pass holders can travel as usual on all services.

## Meadowhall Interchange

This is the only Park & Ride site within South Yorkshire that is served by all three major forms of public transport - bus, train and tram.

The site is situated just off the M1 meaning it is handy for commuting into Sheffield and for taking in the leisure facilities along the Lower Don Valley.

**Location** Meadowhall Interchange, Meadowhall Road, Sheffield, S9 1EP. Access to the Park & Ride site is via Barrow Road.

**Capacity** 330 spaces.

**Open** 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

**Security** Meadowhall Interchange operates a CCTV system and is staffed 24 hours a day. It also holds a Secure Station Award.

### How much does it cost?

Meadowhall operates **FREE** parking. Public transport tickets are an additional cost.

# Why Park & Ride?

Park & Ride is the best of both worlds:

- allowing those who need to use a car the chance to leave it at an Interchange location and link to public transport.
- avoiding the stresses and strains of fighting urban traffic congestion.
- helping to sustain the environment by using public transport and reducing carbon emissions.

## Parking at a Park & Ride site:

- is cost effective - comparing favourably with the cost of parking within towns and city centres.
- has direct links with bus, train or tram facilities.

Sheffield has the added benefit of having sites linked with bus, train and tram facilities.



# Tram Based

There are currently four tram based Park & Ride sites in operation within Sheffield

## Tram site one Nunnery Square

The Nunnery Square site is handy for both the main M1 Sheffield - Sheffield city centre Parkway link, and the road system serving the Lower Don Valley.

Drivers approaching the city centre from the east of Sheffield via any of the major roads can now choose to avoid both heavy traffic congestion and the hunt for car parking. This site links with all the tram routes.

**Location** Off Parkway, Sheffield, S2 5BD  
Telephone: 0114 270 1497.

**Capacity** 380 spaces.

**Open** 0630-1930 Monday to Saturday.  
Exit after 1930 is permissible with a valid Park & Ride ticket until 2359.

**Security** Nunnery Square operates a CCTV system and is staffed during opening hours.  
This site also has Secure Car Park status.

## Tram site two Halfway

Located within a mile from Crystal Peaks Shopping Centre and Drakehouse Retail Park, the Halfway site is popular with motorists travelling from the south or south east of Sheffield wanting to link with Supertram for easy access into Sheffield. Located on the Blue route tram towards Malin Bridge.

**Location** Eckington Way, Halfway, Sheffield, S19 5GS  
Telephone: 0114 248 8263.

**Capacity** 200 spaces.

**Open** 0630-1930 Monday to Saturday.  
Exit after 1930 is permissible with a valid Park & Ride ticket until 2359.

**Security** Halfway operates a CCTV system and is staffed during opening hours. This site also has Secure Car Park status.

## Tram site three Middlewood

The site is perfectly placed for drivers approaching Sheffield from the west and north west of Sheffield. Being a tram based site it offers a quick and comfortable ride into town, avoiding any traffic problems around the busy Hillsborough and Shalesmoor areas of Sheffield.

**Location** Middlewood Road, Hillsborough, Sheffield, S6 1TQ, Telephone: 0114 281 2810.

**Capacity** 350 spaces.

**Open** 0630-1930 Monday to Saturday.  
Exit after 1930 is permissible with a valid Park & Ride ticket until 2359.

**Security** Middlewood operates a CCTV system and is staffed during opening hours. This site also has Secure Car Park status.

## Tram site four Malin Bridge

The site is perfectly placed for drivers approaching Sheffield from the west and north west of Sheffield. Being a tram based site it offers a quick and comfortable ride into town, avoiding any traffic problems around the busy Hillsborough and Shalesmoor areas of Sheffield.

**Location** Holme Lane, Sheffield, S6 4JR.

**Capacity** 104 spaces.

**Open** 0545-2359 Monday to Saturday.  
Exit after 2359 is permissible with a valid Park & Ride ticket.

**Security** Malin Bridge operates a CCTV system and has Help Points located within the car park for help and assistance during opening hours.

**Cost** **£1.00** for car only.

Special savers are available for those parking after 1800 on Saturdays.

Each additional passenger must pay their own fare on the tram or from the kiosk at the site.
