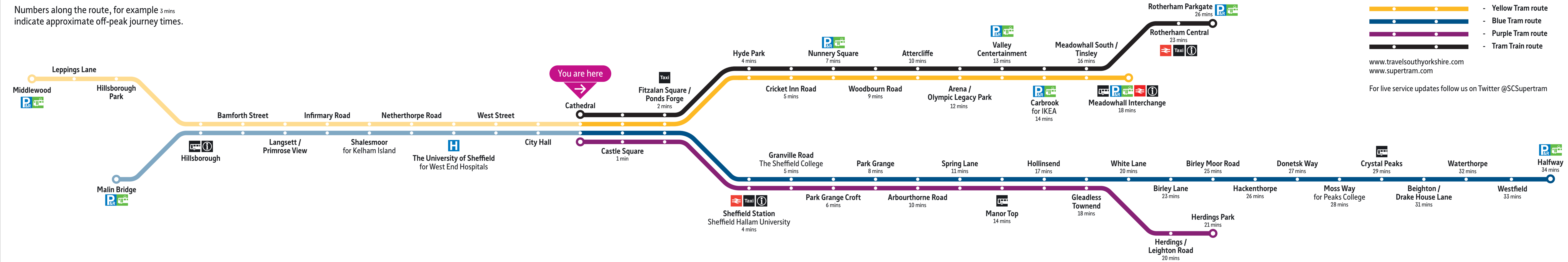


Cathedral

Tickets

All trams have conductors who can provide tickets* and information. They carry a limited supply of change so please try to tender the correct fare whenever possible. If you are planning to take more than one journey, a dayrider could be the best option. Day Stagecoach and Travelmaster tickets and weekly Stagecoach tickets are also available on the Stagecoach Bus App.

Card Payments are accepted on tram

Short distance single	£2.40	Single tickets are valid on the tram for one hour. More than one tram may be boarded within this time but travel must be away from the initial boarding point. Check with the conductor to ensure you purchase the appropriate ticket.
Longer distance single	£2.80	
Short distance return	£4.00	Valid for one return journey where the single fare would be a short distance single. (For longer return journeys see day tickets).

Tram Only DayRider	£5.40	Valid on the Supertram network in Sheffield, includes Tram Train route to Rotherham Parkgate.
DayRider Silver	£6.20	Supertram services including Tram Train & Stagecoach buses in South Yorkshire & Chesterfield.
Citywide	£6.30	Tram & any bus in the Sheffield fare zone only. Not valid to Rotherham on Tram Train.
SYConnect	£8.60	Valid on Supertram and any bus anywhere in South Yorkshire.

Tram Only MegaRider	£19.00**	Valid on the Supertram network in Sheffield, includes Tram Train route to Rotherham Parkgate.
MegaRider Silver	£21.00	Supertram services including Tram Train & Stagecoach buses in South Yorkshire & Chesterfield.
Citywide	£23.40**	Tram & any bus in the Sheffield fare zone. Smartcard only, initial additional smartcard cost of £1.00. Not valid to Rotherham on Tram Train.
SYConnect	£32.20**	Valid on Supertram and any bus anywhere in South Yorkshire. Smartcard only, initial additional smartcard cost of £1.00.

Children under 5 years

Free

Children 5 - 11 years

£1.00

No pass required.

Young People (11 - 18)

£1.00

Children 11 - 16 yrs require a valid South Yorkshire Zoom pass. Child day and weekly tickets are also available on board. Young People aged 16 - 18 require a valid South Yorkshire 16-18 Travel Pass.

Zoom Beyond Single

£2.00

Holders of a valid Zoom Beyond Pass can purchase a £2 fare which is valid for any single journey. A £4 Zoom Beyond Return is also available on tram.

Senior Citizens

Free

From 9.30am until 11.00pm weekdays and at any time weekends and Bank Holidays with a valid older person's English National pass.

Disabled Person's Pass

Free

At all times with a valid disabled person's English National pass.

Group Tram Only Dayrider

£11.00

Group Tram Only Dayrider tickets are valid for two adults and three children (children under the age of 16 proof of age may be required). Group Tram Only Dayriders are valid on all Supertram network including Tram Train.

Park & Ride

Free to park, valid ticket required for travel.

* A penalty fare system operates on board Supertram. You must make every effort to tender your fare or valid pass to a member of staff. Failure to do so may result in a £10 penalty fare being charged. Fare information is correct at time of print and may be subject to change. Ticketing and pass information correct at date of print.

How to use the Tram

There is no need to buy your tram ticket before you board as there are conductors on every tram, however tickets may be cheaper if purchased using the Stagecoach Bus App or online at stagecoachbus.com/tickets

Our conductors are there to give travel advice and sell you the ticket you need. The points below will make your journey easier and we look forward to welcoming you on board.

At the tram stop

- Ensure that you are on the correct platform for the destination and direction you want. This information is located at the very top of this notice.
- As the tram approaches the destination will be displayed on both ends and on either side. The coloured square on the ends shows the route colour and corresponds to the map above.
- Please make your way to the strips of ribbed paving which are located towards the end of the platform, this area is where the tram doors will be when the tram comes to a stop.
- Once the tram has stopped please stand back to allow enough room for the doors to open and for passengers to get off. If the doors do not open, press the round button on the tram door. The button will light up once it is activated and an audible alarm sounds as the doors open.

Once on-board

- Please move away from the doors if possible. We recommend that passengers sit down when seats are available to keep walkways clear.
- The conductor will come to collect your fare or check your ticket or pass. Please have tickets, passes or cash ready and offer it to the conductor as they pass. Card and cash payments are accepted on tram and if paying by cash, the correct change is always helpful.
- There is audio and visual information on the tram which provide next stop information.
- Trams operate on a request to stop basis, as the tram approaches the stop you require press one of the orange buttons located throughout the tram, this will let the driver know that you require that stop.
- Tram doors do not open automatically! Once the tram has stopped the large round buttons on either side of the doors or on the door itself will light up, press the button to open the doors (stay clear of the door and bars as they open) an alarm will sound as the doors open and close. Do not attempt to exit through the door if the closing alarm sounds.
- Only folding bicycles which are folded are allowed.
- Assistance dogs are welcome on all services, without restriction but we ask that dogs do not sit on the seats. Other small dogs can only be carried when they are in a suitable pet container. Larger dogs that aren't able to be carried in a suitable pet container are not permitted.
