Due to industrial action at Network Rail, we won't be able to run as many trams to Rotherham Central and Parkgate as normal.

An hourly service will run to Parkgate in the daytime with all other Tram Train services diverted to Meadowhall Interchange instead of Rotherham. Local bus services are available between Meadowhall Interchange and Rotherham Interchange, also between Rotherham Interchange and Parkgate.
